

QUAY ARTS is the central creative hub on the Island. It is based in two listed harbour-side buildings in the heart of Newport, by the River Medina. It's a registered charity (under the name of Steve Ross Foundation for the Arts) and its purposes are "the fostering and development of artistic knowledge, practice and understanding for the education of the public in the arts, creative practice and their presentation and development". It aims to transform the lives of individuals on the Island and beyond by raising and enabling creative ambitions. **It is fantastically placed to help young people on their Arts Award journey.**
